2008 Zone 10 Specifications

In accordance with GR 903.6: CA-contiguous states are AZ & OR. Nevada - contiguous states are AZ, UT, OR, ID.

Adult Amateur Hunters:

Open to horses and ponies to be ridden by Amateurs who are no longer eligible to compete as Junior Exhibitors. Horses or riders may not cross enter into any Amateur Owner hunter class (at the same show). Riders may not cross enter into First Year, Second Year or Regular Working Hunter at the same show. Adult Amateur Riders may not cross enter into any class at the same show with fences exceeding 3'3" except Adult Amateur Jumpers, Junior/Amateur Modified Jumpers, Equitation and Medal Classes. **An Adult Amateur rider may ride an Amateur Owner Hunter in the A/O Hunter Under Saddle Class.** No cross entry restrictions at one-day shows. Fence height 3', spreads not to exceed fence height.

Horses and ponies will not be jogged for soundness.

Children's Hunters:

Open to horses and ponies to be ridden by Junior Exhibitors. Horses or riders may not cross enter into any Junior Hunter Class (at the same show). Riders may not cross enter into First Year, Second Year or Regular Working Hunters at the same show. Children Riders may not cross enter into any class at the same show with fences exceeding 3'3" except Children's Jumpers, Junior/Amateur Modified Jumpers, Equitation and Medal Classes. **A Junior rider may ride a Junior Hunter in the Junior Hunter Under Saddle Class.** No cross entry restrictions at one-day shows. Fence height 3'; spreads not exceed fence height. Horses and ponies will not be jogged for soundness.

If a separate Children's Hunter Pony Division is offered, **fences must be set at 2' for small/medium ponies** and 2'6 for large ponies, spreads may not exceed fence height. Riders may not cross enter in any division where the fences exceed 3'3" (except Children's Jumpers).

Children's Jumpers:

Open to Junior Exhibitors. Horses or riders may not cross enter into any Junior Jumper class at the same show. Children's Jumper riders may not cross enter into any jumper class at the same show with fences exceeding **1.15 meter (3'9")** except Junior/Amateur Modified Jumpers. No cross entry restrictions at one day shows. **Fences to be set at 1.10 meter (3'7") for the first class of the section. In all other classes of the section fences to be set no lower than 1.10 meter (3'7") and no higher than 1.15 meter (3'9").**

Adult Amateur Jumpers:

Open to Amateur riders. Horses or riders may not cross enter into any Amateur Owner Jumper class at the same show. Adult Amateur Jumper riders may not cross enter into any jumper class with fences exceeding 1.15 meter (3'9") except Junior/Amateur Modified Jumpers. No cross entry restrictions at one day shows. **Fences to be set at 1.10 meter (3'7") for the first class of the section. In all other classes of the section fences to be set no lower than 1.10 meter (3'7") and no higher than 1.15 meter (3'9").**

Pre-Green Hunter:

A Pre-Green Hunter is a horse that is not a First Year, Second Year or Regular Hunter under USEF rules. A horse may show as a pre-Green Hunter for no more than two years once it has reached five years of age. The Pre-Green section will receive C-rated points. Pre-Green Classics will be awarded points equal to those given in USEF "B" Hunter Classics. Fence Heights 3'.

Pony Hunter Breeding:

Open to ponies of any breeding that are suitable to become pony hunters. Classes must be offered for yearlings, two-year-olds and three-year-olds. A Championship class must be offered. The first place pony in each class to return for the championship class. Second place ponies may return. Classes may not be combined but may be split by sex if there are sufficient entries. Classes are judged on conformation, way of moving, quality, substance, soundness and suitability to become pony hunters. Ponies are to be walked and jogged before being placed in order of preference. Classes may be adjudicated by a Hunter Breeding Judge, Registered Hunter Judge or a Recorded Hunter Judge. (GR1004.10)

Classics:

Classics counting for year end Zone awards may be offered for Adult Amateur, Children's and Pre-Green Hunters with bonus points being awarded as per **GR 921** using "B" points. Classics may either be held as a separate two round class, or a class in the division may count as one round of the classic. Height and spread of fences will be the same as required for the respective section. Classics must offer at least \$500 in prize money.
