2008 Zone 12 Specifications

Zone 12 chooses no contiguous states.

Adult Amateur Hunter:

Open to horses and ponies. All entrants must be ridden by amateur exhibitors in possession of a current USEF amateur card. To be shown over a minimum of eight obstacles 2'9" in height, spreads not to exceed height of obstacle. To be judged on performance and soundness; manners and suitability will be emphasized; extreme speed shall be penalized. Horses not to jog. **Adult Amateur Hunter classes may be combined with Children's Hunter classes.**

Children's Hunter:

Open to horses and ponies. All entrants must be ridden by Junior exhibitors in all phases of the class. To be shown over a minimum of eight obstacles 2'9" in height, spreads not to exceed height of obstacle. To be judged on performance and soundness; manners and suitability will be emphasized; extreme speed shall be penalized. Horses not to jog. **Children's Hunter classes may be combined with Adult Amateur Hunter classes.**

Children's Jumper: Fences to be set at a specific height within the corresponding Level

Open to horses and ponies. Any horse and pony regardless of money won is eligible to compete in this division. All entrants must be ridden by junior exhibitors. Classes to be conducted per USEF rules, Jumper Division. Entrants to be shown over a minimum of eight obstacles at Level 1 fence dimensions. Children's Jumper classes may be combined with Adult Amateur Jumper classes.

Adult Amateur Jumper: Fences to be set at a specific height within the corresponding Level

Open to horses and ponies. Any horse and pony regardless of money won is eligible to compete in this division. All entrants must be ridden by amateur exhibitors in possession of a current USEF Amateur Card. Classes to be conducted per USEF rules, Jumper Division. Entrants to be shown over a minimum of eight obstacles at Level 1 fence dimensions. Adult Amateur Jumper classes may be combined with Children's Jumper classes.
