1. Attendance. The June 4, 2007 Zone 12 committee meeting began at 6:45 p.m. with a quorum of Mary Kaye Hession, Bill Turner, Rebecca Weiant, Rebecca Carrington, Dana Eaton and Terri Wangstrom. Susie Kaiser, Sigrun Robertson and Jaime Freeman were not present.
2. Secretary's Report and Treasurer's Report. The minutes were approved as corrected. The treasurer's report was presented with a balance of \$3,814.22.
3. Budget. Mary Kaye reported that Rebecca Carrington, Bill Turner and herself would meet with Sara Pisani to go over budget questions.
4. National Hunter Council. Mary Kaye reported that the Zone Council and Zone treasurer's met with Sara on May 21 to discuss the budget proposals. There was also discussion of changing the hunters to a "Level" system like the jumpers. She also mentioned the discussion brought on by Zone 1's rule proposal to combine AO's with the Junior Hunters.
5. Horsemanship Challenge. Rebecca Weiant reported she received paperwork from Anne Henry, but would need a clinician's name before sending in the paperwork. It was agreed the fee for the entries would be \$40 with a late fee of \$45. Dana Eaton requested samples/study guides information to be made available for students to study from. Rebecca Weiant agreed to settle on a source by August 1st.
6. Young Riders Clinic. Dana Eaton reported that Bernie Traurig clinic would be held July 27, 28, and 29. She projected the budget based on 15 entries with \$325 per entry. There was also discussion on what scholarships to be handed out. It was noted that no memberships forms or money has been turned into Terri Wangstrom.
7. Zone Finals. Mary Kaye reported she was working on the prize list, Jaime was working on the cover page, and that she would get approval for the USHJA logo as required. Dana brought up a question regarding handing out USHJA Blankets/Coolers versus the donated ones from Solstice Saddlery. Mary Kaye asked that Rebecca Carrington and Terri Wangstrom to be on the Show Committee.

There was also lots of discussion regarding the prize list and classes held and three or less riders. Various motions were made regarding on whether to pay out the prize money if the class was held whether it had less than three riders. A motion was made to pay out the prize money if the class was held. Then various motions were passed to determine whether a class should be held if it had less than three riders. A motion was made that the show management would go to the show committee on whether to hold the class if there was less than three riders.

Bill Turner reported on the lack of availability of big "R" judges. Mary Kaye reported that they were able to reserve Dawn Nugen as the show Steward.

Also discussed was whether to send out a qualification letter or not. It was decided to not to send out the qualification letters. It was also noted an emergency plan is also required, it was decided to use the Alaska Dressage Associations.

8. New Business. Rebecca mentioned that her office building will be available for the next four months.
9. Next Meeting. The meeting adjourned at 8:35 p.m. The next meeting is to be a conference of the full committee and will take place at 6:30 p.m. on Monday, July 2, 2007, at Rebecca's workplace with committee members wishing to teleconference in phoning Rebecca at (907) 276-1454 to join.
