1. Attendance. The May 7, 2007 Zone 12 committee meeting began at 6:45 p.m. with a quorum of Mary Kaye Hession, Rebecca Weiant, Rebecca Carrington, Jaime Freeman, Sigrun Robertson and Terri Wangstrom. Susie Kaiser and Dana Eaton were not present.
2. Secretary's Report and Treasurer's Report. The minutes were approved as corrected. The treasurer's report was presented with a balance of \$3,814.22.
3. National Hunter Council. Mary Kaye reported that we are a joint hunter/jumper zone committee again. The Amateur committee has abandoned the idea of setting national criteria. USEF told Melissa Pylant it couldn't give us a spreadsheet of membership and recording dates. Also mentioned was the May 21 meeting at Noon to hear Sara Pisani's budget instructions for treasurers.

Deadlines were also discussed. Mary Kaye had sent out the 2008 Pony Jumper criteria with no changes. Upcoming deadlines included the 2008 NAYRC, Prix de States, Children's/AA jumpers and USEF rule change proposals.

4. Horsemanship Challenge. Rebecca Weiant reported working on the project, but would need additional information as to who the judge would be before she could progress.
5. Zone Finals. Mary Kaye reported that Joe Kornegay would be unable to act as show manager. Bill Turner then motioned that if Sigrun Robertson and Mary Kay both agreed; to accept them to be the Zone 12 Finals Show Management Team. Motion was seconded by Terri Wangstrom and passed unanimously.

Information was also shared regarding the Finals Budget. USHJA offered a mass order for Final Awards, but it we mentioned we had a sponsor saving costs there. There was discussion on the steward in trying to see whom the steward was locally and if she would be available saving costs on travel fees.

Bill Turner volunteered to be the course designer and to assist with providing the ring crew. Bill was also going to assist with locating a judge.

Mary Kaye was going to work on the prize list. Jaime volunteered to assist on designing the cover as it was noted that the previous Finals Jump contest winner was to be on the cover.

Rebecca Wieant volunteered to be the announcer.

6. Young Riders Clinic. Terri Wangstrom reported that she had heard that Bernie Traurig would be available, but possibly only during the time of July 27, 28 & 29. Dana was unavailable to ask for additional information. Bill Turner motioned to approve getting Dana to request Bernie for the YR Clinic. Motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

The meeting adjourned at 8:05 p.m. The next meeting is to be a conference of the full committee and will take place at 6:30 p.m. on Monday, May 7, 2007, at Rebecca's workplace with committee members wishing to teleconference in phoning Rebecca at (907) 276-1454 to join.
