1. Attendance. The April 2, 2007 Zone 12 committee meeting began at 6:45 p.m. with a quorum of Mary Kaye Hession, Rebecca Weiant, Rebecca Carrington, Jaime Freeman, Sigrun Robertson and Dana Eaton. Susie Kaiser and Terri Wangstrom were not present.
2. Secretary's Report and Treasurer's Report. The minutes were approved as corrected. The treasurer's report was presented with a balance of \$3,814.22.
3. National Hunter Committee. Mary Kaye reported that there were no meetings this past month but were upcoming.

Mary Kay did report Melissa Plyant and that Melissa had mentioned she could assist with teleconferencing, e-mailed newsletters, but they would have to be USHJA approved first. Mary Kaye had also mentioned that she had requested a list of current members.

4. Horsemanship Challenge. Rebecca Weiant reported that Dana Hall of Solstice Saddlery was willing to sponsor the clinic again. There was discussion of dropping the riding clinic and just doing the Judges Eye clinic and the Horsemanship Challenge on the day after the Zone Finals. There was discussion about putting in a request to ASH for sponsoring the Judges Eye clinic.

There was discussion about who might be willing to be show manager with various committee members planning on thinking it over. It was also mentioned that the finals needed a show steward for the next two years. There was also discussion regarding adding the modified children's/adult amateur classes to the finals, but was noted that this idea was turned down during previous meetings.

6. Young Riders Clinic. Terri Wangstrom was unavailable to report, but Dana Enz reported that Bernie Traurig was volunteering to do the clinic for two days; airfare, room and car rental would need to be included though.
7. Next Meeting.
