

## 2011 Proposed Zone 10 Specifications

### 2011 Zone 10 Specifications (CA, NV)

In accordance with GR1111.4: All members may compete for Zone Awards or money in any state contiguous to Zone 10: OR, ID, UT, AZ

#### Adult Amateur Hunters:

Open to horses and ponies to be ridden by Amateurs who are no longer eligible to compete as Junior Exhibitors. Horses or riders may not cross enter into any Amateur Owner hunter class (at the same show). Riders may not cross enter into First Year, Second Year or Regular Working Hunter at the same show. Adult Amateur Riders may not cross enter into any class at the same show with fences exceeding 3'3" except Adult Amateur Jumpers, Junior/Amateur Modified Jumpers, Equitation and Medal Classes. An Adult Amateur rider may ride an Amateur Owner Hunter in the A/O Hunter Under Saddle Class.) No cross entry restrictions at one-day shows. Fence height: 3'; spreads not to exceed fence height. Horses and ponies will not be jogged for soundness.

#### Children's Hunters:

Open to horses and ponies to be ridden by Junior Exhibitors. Horses or riders may not cross enter into any Junior Hunter Class at the same show. Riders may not cross enter into First Year, Second Year or Regular Working Hunters at the same show. Children Riders may not cross enter into any class at the same show with fences exceeding 3'3" except Children's Jumpers, Junior/Amateur Modified Jumpers, Equitation and Medal Classes. A Children's Hunter rider may ride a Junior Hunter in the Junior Hunter Under Saddle Class. No cross entry restrictions at one-day shows. Fence height: 3'; spreads not to exceed fence height. Horses and ponies will not be jogged for soundness. If a separate Children's Hunter Pony Division is offered, fences must be set at 2' for small/medium ponies and 2'6 for large ponies, spreads may not exceed fence height. Riders may not cross enter in any division where the fences exceed 3'3" (except Children's Jumpers).

#### Children's Jumpers:

Open to Junior Exhibitors. Horses or riders may not cross enter into any Junior Jumper class at the same show. Children's Jumper riders may not cross enter into any jumper class at the same show with fences exceeding ~~1.15m (3'9")~~ **1.20m (3'11")** except Junior/Amateur Modified Jumpers. No cross entry restrictions at one day shows. Fences must be set at 1.10m (3'7") for the first class of the section. In all other classes of the section fences to be set no lower than 1.10m (3'7") and no higher than 1.15m (3'9").

#### Adult Amateur Jumpers:

Open to Amateur riders. Horses or riders may not cross enter into any Amateur Owner Jumper class at the same show. Adult Amateur Jumper riders may not cross enter into any jumper class with fences exceeding ~~1.15m (3'9")~~ **1.20m (3'11")** except Junior/Amateur Modified Jumpers. No cross entry restrictions at one day shows. Fences to be set at 1.10m (3'7") for the first class of the section. In all other classes of the section fences to be set no lower than 1.10m (3'7") and no higher than 1.15m (3'9").

#### Low Children's Jumpers:

Open to Junior Exhibitors. Horses or riders may not cross enter into any Junior Jumper class at the same show. Low Children's Jumper riders may not cross enter into any jumper class at the same show with fences exceeding 1.10m (3'7") except Junior/Amateur Modified Jumpers and Regular Children's Jumper. No cross entry restrictions at one day shows. Fences to be set at 1.0m (3'3") to 1.05m (3'5").

#### Low Adult Jumpers Revised:

Open to Adult riders. Horses or riders may not cross enter into any Amateur Owner Jumper class at the same show. Low Adult Jumper riders may not cross enter into any jumper class with fences exceeding 1.10m (3'7") except Junior/Amateur Modified Jumpers and Regular Adult Amateur Jumper. No cross entry restrictions at one day shows. Fences to be set at 1.0m (3'3") to 1.05m (3'5").

#### Pre-Green Hunter:

A Pre-Green Hunter is a horse that is not a First Year, Second Year or Regular Hunter under USEF rules. A horse may show as a Pre-Green Hunter for no more than two years once it has reached five years of age. The Pre-Green section will receive C-rated points. Pre-Green Classics will be awarded points equal to those given in USEF "B" Hunter Classics. Fence Heights: 3' and 3'3". Horses may not cross-enter into 3'6" divisions. Horses not to jog.

**There will be two annual awards for the Pre-Green sections: 3' and 3'3".**

**Classics:**

Classics counting for year end Zone awards may be offered for Adult Amateur, Children's and Pre-Green Hunters with bonus points being awarded as per GR 1129.5 using "B" points. Classics may either be held as a separate two round class, or a class in the division may count as one round of the classic. Height and spread of fences will be the same as required for the respective section. Classics must offer at least \$500 in prize money.

**Junior Jumper (Prix des States) Championship:**

*Criteria:* Junior and Open Jumper classes offering \$1,000 or more in prize money held at 1.40m (4'7") or above (including Open Jumper classes offering \$25,000 or more in prize money) between January 1st 2011 and August 31st 2011. All classes must be held at USEF recognized competitions offering at least \$2,500 in their Jumper Division.

**Pony Jumper Championship:**

*Classes to count:* Pony Jumper classes held at heights of 0.95m (3'1") or above but less than 1.00m (3'3") will count at one-half point value; Pony Jumper or Low Children's Jumper\* classes held at 1.00m (3'3") or above but less than 1.10m (3'7") will count at full point value; and Pony Jumper or Children's Jumper\* classes held at 1.10m (3'7") or above will count at one and one-half point value.

*Qualifying period:* June 2, 2010 through June 1, 2011
