Children's/Adult Amateur

The **Children's/Adult Amateur Hunter Task Force** is a Hunter Working Group Task Force that reports to the Hunter Working Group. Members shall serve terms of two years.

The work of the Children's/Adult Amateur Hunter Task Force supports the USHJA mission, which is to serve our members through educational programs, awards and recognition, communication and rules.

The task force's goal is to:

- Provide a Championship for Children's and Adult Amateur Hunter riders that will promote growth at this level of the sport and provide riders the opportunity to work together in a team environment

The purpose of the Children's/Adult Amateur Hunter Task Force is to create, promote and support programs for the Children's and Adult Amateur hunter constituency. They are committed to developing opportunities for further progression, participation and retention in our sport while addressing the need to retain a fair and level playing field in these sections.

Responsibilities:

- Consider how rules affect Children's or Adult Amateur Hunter riders and suggest or review proposed rule changes if necessary
- Monitor the implementation and progress of the Children's/Adult Amateur Hunter Championships
- Address any issues that arise regarding the Children's/Adult Amateur Hunter Championships
- Create specifications for the Children's/Adult Amateur Hunter Championships each year
