Junior Hunter

The **Junior Hunter Task Force** is a Hunter Working Group Task Force that reports to Hunter Working Group. Members shall serve terms of two years.

The work of the Junior Hunter Task Force supports the USHJA mission, which is to serve our members through educational programs, awards and recognition, communication and rules.

The task force's goal is to:

- Promote and revitalize the Junior hunter section as a staple and important stepping stone on the ladder of creating the strong and well-rounded American rider.

The purpose of the Junior Hunter Task Force is to provide a voice to junior riders, trainers and owners in the sport and promote the continuous growth of the section while monitoring its implementation in competition.

Responsibilities:

- Consider how rules affect Junior Hunter riders and suggest or review proposed rule changes if necessary
- Provide a list of recommended judges for Junior Hunter Finals to the USEF
- Review Specifications for the Junior Hunter Finals.
- Identify and address any issues that arise with the section in the sport.
