- Overview of stable and show barn management.

- Complete stable and stall set-up.
- Grooming practical: Stable Manager demonstrates proper grooming techniques and tack cleaning procedures. Groups disperse to get horses groomed and tack cleaned.
- Presentation of horses in full tack: Stable Manager will check each horse for proper equipment fit. Discuss any changes that may be necessary prior to riding.
- If time allows, Stable Manager may assign light riding or lunging.
