Ms. Pearson stated that would be added.

### **IV. Sallie B. Wheeler Championship Sponsorship**

Ms. Pearson stated Zone 4 was being asked if they would like to be a sponsor for the Sallie B. Wheeler East Hunter Breeding Championships.
