

# USHJA Show Jumping Rider Ranking List Guidelines

## I. USHJA Show Jumping Rider Ranking List

- A. The USHJA will maintain one national ranking list. The list will also be separated into three regions; East, Central, and West, based on a rider's home zone.
- East – Zone 1, Zone 2, Zone 3, Zone 4
  - Central – Zone 5, Zone 6, Zone 7, Zone 8
  - West – Zone 9, Zone 10, Zone 11, Zone 12
- B. Rider's points may be earned anywhere in the country. Riders may compete on multiple horses but will only be pointed on their highest placed horse.

## II. Ranking List Class Criteria

### A. USHJA Level 1 Classes

USHJA Level 1 classes are those that meet the following requirements:

- ½ points per dollar earned
- Points capped at \$15,000
- Fence heights: 1.35m – 1.40m
- Minimum of \$10,000 prize money
- Limit of one Level 1 ranking list class per competition
- Class not part of a section
- USEF Regional Standard Grand Prixes of \$25,000 or more fall within the parameters of Level 1.

### B. USHJA Level 2 Classes

USHJA Level 2 Ranking List classes are those that meet the following requirements:

- One point per dollar earned
- Points capped at \$25,000
- Fence heights: 1.40m – 1.45m
- Minimum of \$15,000 prize money
- Limit of one Level 2 ranking list class per competition
- Class not part of a section
- USEF American Standard Grand Prixes of \$25,000 or more fall within the parameters of Level 2.

*Only the highest prize money class from each Level will count toward USHJA Ranking points.*

- C. If a competition offers more than one class in each category, the highest prize money class in that category will be the USHJA Show Jumping Rider Ranking List designated class.
- D. Competition management must list their class for Level 1 and/or Level 2 in their results to USEF with the specific USHJA Rider Ranking List class number. Competitions do not have to apply to the USHJA for their competitions to count. Shows may only have one class of each category recognized. For example, a show may have a Welcome Stake that meets the criteria of Level 1 and a grand prix that meets the criteria of Level 2, in which case both classes will be pointed.

## III. Reporting Results

- A. Results must be submitted to USEF with the specific class number for their Level 1 and/or Level 2 classes to count toward the Ranking List.
- Level 1 class number: 1000L1
  - Level 2 class number: 1000L2
