

USHJA JUMPER COURSE DESIGN CLINIC January 14-15, 2019 Wellington, FL

Open to USEF licensed Jumper Course Designers, applicants, and those interested in becoming licensed. Attendance fulfills the clinic requirements as outlined in Chapter 10 of the USEF rule book. Discount registration deadline is **December 5, 2018,** and is subject to cancellation if sufficient interest is not established by that date. Additional clinics held at this site include a Hunter Course Design clinic, to be held January 14, 2019.

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'R' SESSION

Registered (R) jumper course designers may choose one of two options to complete their clinic requirement:

- Attend the clinic in Wellington, FL, on January 14, 2019, or
- Submit three course designs to USHJA via email (<u>loeducation@ushja.org</u>).
 - If this option is used, the courses must have been:
 - Used in competition within the past two years
 - From a minimum of two different competitions
 - Be for the three classes with the highest specifications for which the course designer has officiated within the past two years
 - Each course must be submitted with the specifications of the class, dimensions of the jumps, distances, dimensions of the arena, and if possible a copy of the judge's card.
 - Courses must be drawn to scale and indicate the scale used.
 - o Panelists selected by the USHJA Officials Committee will review the courses, provide comments on each and return them to the course designer.
 - Must be completed before September 30, 2019

ATTENDANCE

- Please complete the online registration form in advance of the December 5, 2018 deadline.
- Attendance sheets must be signed at each session to receive credit for the clinic. If you arrive more than one hour later than the scheduled starting time, or leave more than one hour earlier than the scheduled adjournment, you will not receive credit for attending the clinic.
- Online registrations receive immediate confirmation via emailed receipt, no additional email will be sent.
- 'R' attendees are only required to attend Monday night, but are more than welcome to join the Tuesday session if they desire. 'r' and applicant attendees are only required to attend the Tuesday session, but are strongly encouraged to attend the Monday night 'R' roundtable.

HOMEWORK

- Attendees must provide homework submission to the USHJA via email (<u>LOeducation@ushja.org</u>) by Monday, December 17, 2018.
- 'R' attendees should submit one course they have used within the past two years. It should be course that can
 provide discussion points such as how it worked great for a particular show, problems that may have
 occurred, etc.
- 'r' and applicant attendees should submit three courses in an outdoor arena measuring 150' wide by 280' long with the in-gate at the center of one of the short sides. One course should be built for a 5 Year Old, Table II class that takes place after July 1. The second course should be built for a 1.10 Children's/Adult Amateur, Table II, Sec. 1 class. The third course should be built for a \$5,000 1.40 Junior/Amateur Owner Classic, Table II, Sec. 2 (b) class.
 - The arena should be drawn portrait, so the in-gate will be on the short side at the bottom of the page. Use the same template on which you will present the finished paperwork to the judge and competitors.
 - The courses should be different, but not require extensive changes, as time between classes is limited. However, feel free to change direction of the fences, move jumps, or add jumps during the changes in order to provide variety.

 Please remember to include the height and width of the fences, distances for combinations and any measurable lines, and scale of the ring

Please dress professionally and appropriately.

VENUE INFORMATION

This clinic is being held at the Wellington Club, located inside the Palm Beach International Equestrian Center – 14440 Pierson Rd. Wellington, FL 33414. The Wellington Club is located straight through the main entrance between the International and Grand Hunter rings.

HOTEL INFORMATION

This clinic is being held entirely at the WEF showgrounds, therefore USHJA has not reserved a room block at a hotel. Nearby hotels include the Hampton Inn & Suites (2155 Wellington Green Dr. Village of Wellington, FL 33467, (561) 472-9696) or the Embassy Suites West Palm Beach (1601 Belvedere Road, West Palm Beach, FL 33406. AIRPORT

Palm Beach International Airport (PBI) – 12 miles from hotel Fort Lauderdale (FLL) – 50 miles from hotel

DIRECTIONS

From Palm Beach Airport to hotel – turn right onto Australian Avenue, after 0.3 miles stay in right lane to take US-98/FL-80 W/Southern Blvd, continue on US-98/Southern Blvd for 9.4 miles, turn left onto FL-7, after 2.1 miles turn right onto Forest Hill Blvd, after 0.1 miles turn left onto Wellington Green Drive, hotel will be on your right.

From Hotel to Showgrounds – turn left onto Forest Hill Blvd, after 1.1 miles turn left onto South Shore Blvd, after 2.4 miles turn right onto Pierson Rd, after 0.3 miles turn left onto Equestrian Club Drive (main WEF visitor entrance), follow Equestrian Club Drive until you reach the parking lot. Continue straight through the main entrance and the Wellington Club is the first tent building on your left.

FEES

\$210 = 'r' and applicant session, online registration completed on or before December 5, 2018.

\$275 = 'r' and applicant session, online registration completed after December 5, 2018.
