5. Combined Sections. ...

a. Dividing of Combined Sections/*Classes*. After the prize list is published, if entries so warrant this section may be split into separate sections. Any *class* section with fifteen or more Junior Jumper entries and fifteen or more Amateur Owner Jumper entries at the beginning of the first class-must be divided, and the prize money must be doubled. *Exception: Special Classes i.e. Combined Classics or the highest prize money class of the section.*

Rule Change Intent

Many jumpers don't jump every day, especially in the high sections and as a result, the number of entries in a given section of classes can vary throughout a week of competition. Therefore, it would be more equitable for competitors and managers to base the reason for splitting a combined class on the number in the individual classes rather than the number in the first class of a section.
