Due to the pandemic, US Pony Finals were canceled in 2020. The Alvin Topping Governance Grant is awarded annually to assist one USHJA member, (25 years of age or under) with funding to support their attendance at the USHJA or USEF annual meeting. Equestrian Helmet Safety Initiative is dedicated to research that will elevate the study of head impact and concussion risk in an equestrian environment to a new standard. The Foundation contributes monies for the research which will be conducted in lab settings and field video data on a variety of equestrian events with significant attention to jumping, where many injuries occur. This project will set the framework to better understand concussive biomechanics in the equestrian industry and better
