What is it?	Local hunter/jumper organizations can sign up to be USHJA affiliates. They generally offer their own shows that can include both unrated and USEF-licensed competitions. They often tend to be local or state hunter/jumper associations. These schooling shows are often a great first step into the horse show world to gain experience.	Outreach is an awards program where both USEF-licensed and non-licensed or unrated shows offer classes that are designated Outreach classes. Members can gain year-end points and awards throughout the year, and attend special championships designated as Outreach Festivals.	USEF Lite shows are the introductory level of competitions licensed by USEF and are meant to be very beginner friendly. They are often local shows that want to start under the license umbrella of USEF. Lite shows have fewer fees than other USEF Licensed shows.	Regional, Premier and National are show licenses offered and overseen by USEF. Regional is a good entry point to experience showing at fully rated horse shows, which is less intensive than showing at a Premier or National rated show.
Why should I do this?	Affiliate organizations provide shows that are more local, often requiring less travel time than licensed shows. They tend to have classes that are very welcoming for new riders, riders moving up another level and green horses that need show experience. Classes tend to geared more to the preliminary levles. You may need to search a bit more for classes above 3'.	Since Outreach classes can be offered at both licensed and unlicensed shows, they can serve as a wonderful bridge for experiencing a licensed show with low pressure and fewer fees. If you are looking for an awards program that recognizes levels from ground poles to 3' hunters and 1.20m jumpers, then this is a great program to join. It also offers opportunities to expand your showing horizons with local championships called Festivals, the ability to be nominated to compete in a National Affiliate Championship, and get great year-end prizes.
